

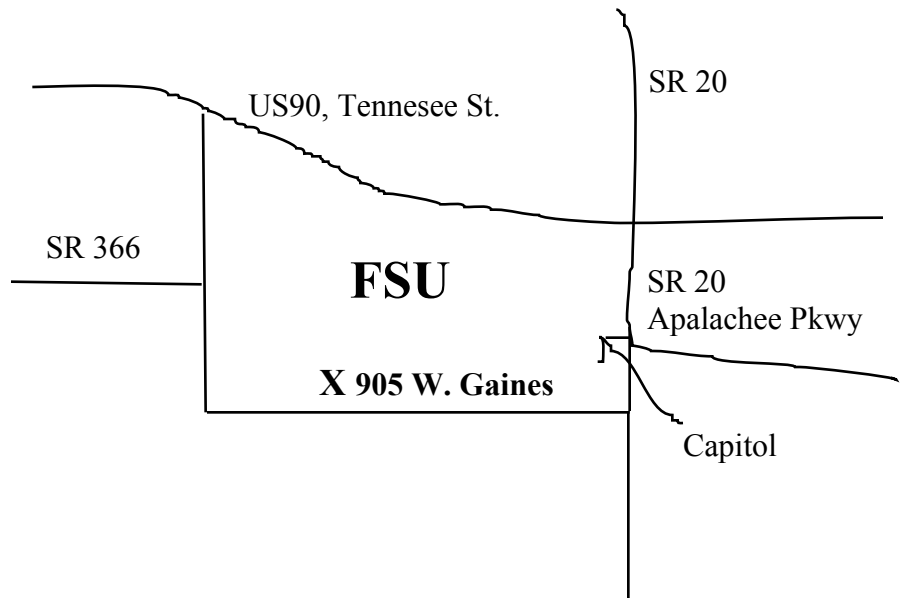
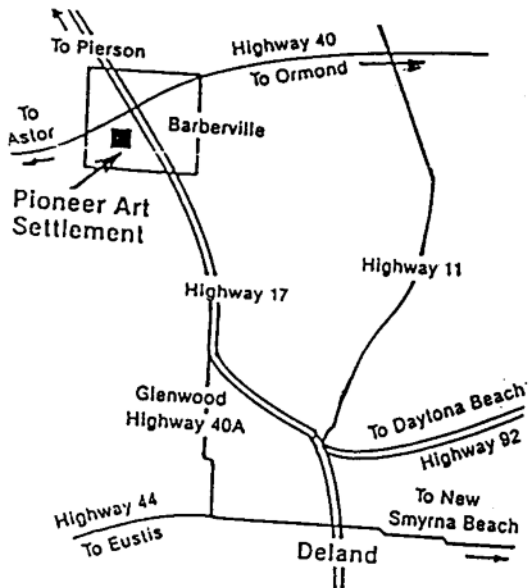
# Calendar of Events

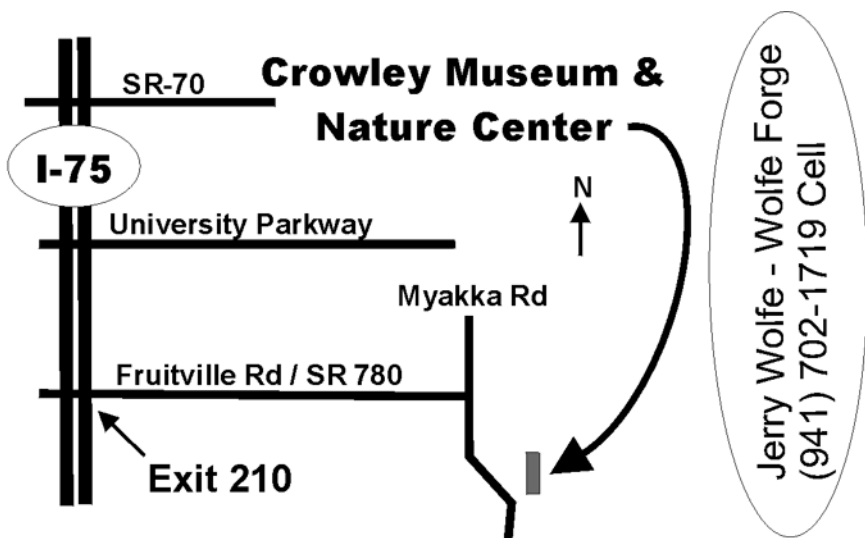
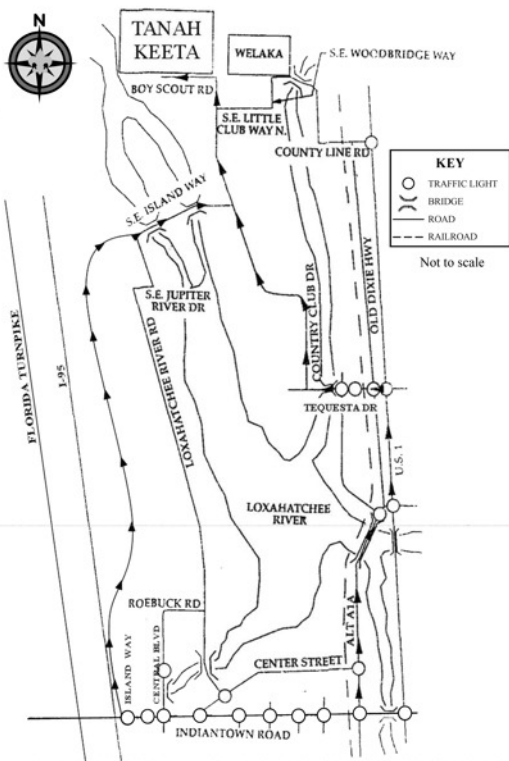
