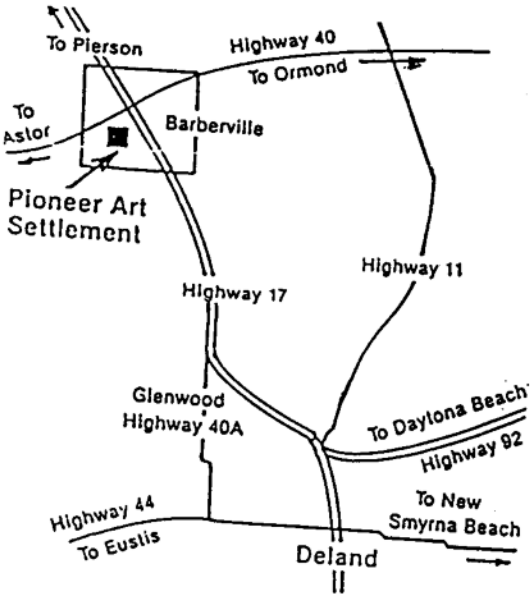


# Calendar of Events

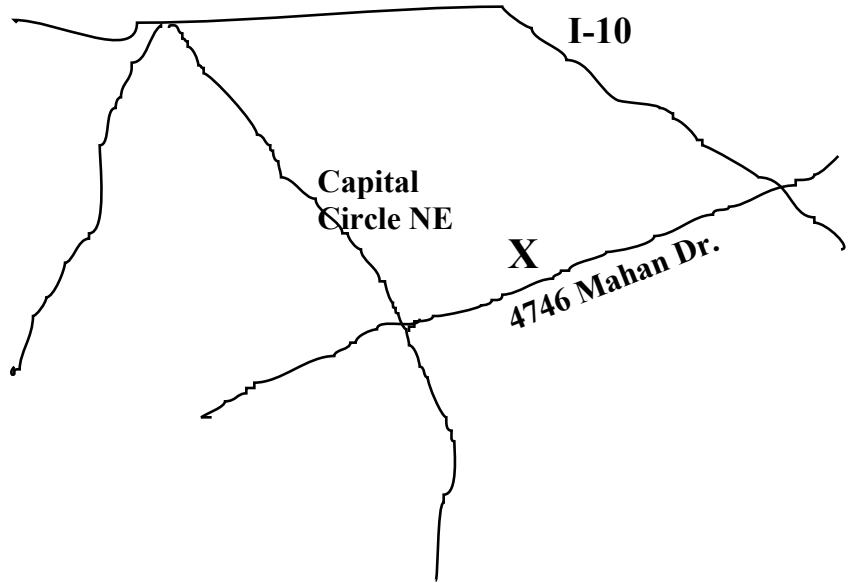

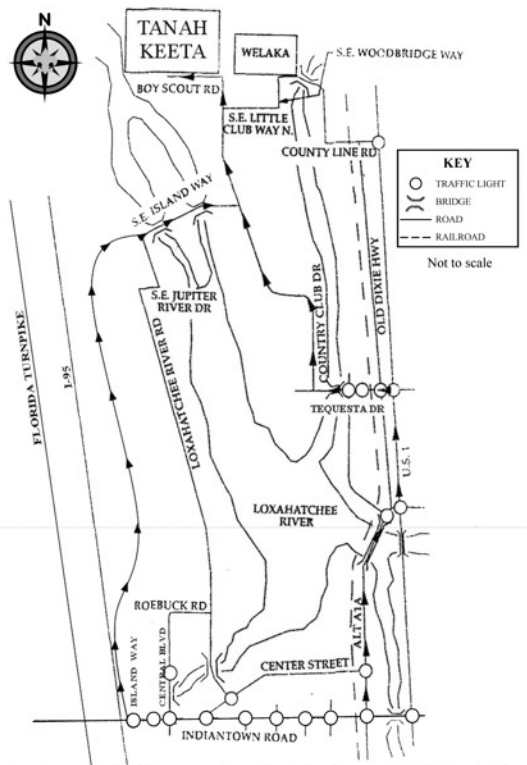

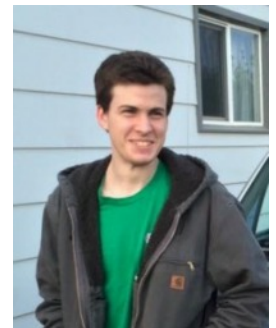
